

Terms and Conditions

Use of the Site

1. All images contained on this website remain the property of John Wood. Images may not be downloaded, reproduced, copied, projected, or used in any way without express written permission.
2. Images may be stored on your computer temporarily as part of the normal process of viewing them on the John Wood Photography website. You must not otherwise copy the images, nor may you use them for any other purpose, whether or not this is for commercial gain. If you would like a licence to use any image then the terms must be agreed in advance in writing - please [contact me](#), advising desired usage.
3. Information that is recorded as a result of your use of the website will be held on computer systems located in the UK. This information will be used (a) in order to assist in fulfilling any orders placed by you and (b) to analyse use of the website. Unless you opt out, the information you provide may be used to advise you of additions to the website. If you no longer wish to receive notifications then it is sufficient to send an email requesting that you are removed from our mailing list. **We do not and never will, pass or sell your personal data to third-parties.**

Purchase of Images

1. Placing an order constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions in full unless any variation is agreed in writing.
2. We make every effort to ensure that the colours of each image are consistent between screen and print when viewed in natural daylight. We cannot guarantee that prints match exactly with the images on your screen since the calibration of your monitor and the conditions in which you view prints are both outside of our control.
3. When you purchase a print from John Wood Photography, title to the print passes to you and you may display the print in any location or manner you choose.
4. Copyright in purchased images remains with the photographer (John Wood) at all times. This means that you are not permitted to duplicate images by any means or in any medium without the prior, written permission of the photographer.
5. Payment is collected through PayPal, whose processes and policies are described on their website; these policies are outside the control of John Wood Photography. Payment may also be made via cheque (drawn on a UK bank in GB £ Sterling) or via bank transfer.
6. In order to determine the correct rate for Postage and Packing, we rely on you to indicate the correct postal area for delivery. If this is not correctly indicated then we will raise an invoice for any shortfall; this invoice must be paid before we will dispatch any prints. If it remains unpaid for more than ten days we reserve the right to cancel the order and refund any monies paid.
